Return to Hockey Update

Hockey Alberta has released its "Return to Hockey Plan" that outlines the framework and standards for member associations to begin planning their hockey programming for the 2020-2021 season.

HOCKEY ALBERTA RETURN TO HOCKEY PLAN

Minor Hockey Association is currently working Strathcona developing protocols and procedures, in conjunction with Strathcona County facilities, that will enable members to return to hockey in a safe environment while ensuring compliance with public health and Hockey Canada/Hockey Alberta requirements. We will host a virtual Town Hall Meeting in early August to share this information with our membership so anticipate an invitation to this in the near future!

This is a dynamic and evolving process but some of the new protocols being recommended during Phase 2 (Development Season) include the following:

Daily Check-In/Contact Tracing **Decreased Occupancy in facilities** 10 min prior arrival Arriving Dressed for activities Increased sanitation No public water fountains ↑ Emphasis on timed drills for evals Potential travel restrictions Distanced Skills/Cond. Camps

Physical Distancing in the Stands Dedicated entry/exit doors Departure 10 min post activity No showers or indoor warm-up Longer breaks between teams No sharing of water bottles Cohorts for early season play Online learning for Coaches Limitations on multi-sports
