Lisa Francioli Scholarship

This scholarship was established in memory of Lisa Francioli who was a dedicated board member, volunteer and hockey supporter. Lisa was involved in SMHA for over a decade. She was also a senior governor of the 1660 hockey league. This scholarship was intended to assist **SMHA U18 (Midget) players** in their pursuit of a post-secondary education. Winners may be in grade 11 or 12 with the award being given when proof of acceptance into post-secondary education is given.

Award Value:

One scholarship will be awarded for a total value of **\$1000.00** per year.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Played a minimum of three years in SMHA
- Must have been enrolled in the SMHA program during 2021-22
- Not have previously received this award

Selection Criteria:

• The award recipient will demonstrate qualities of integrity, humor, commitment to fair play as well as being respectful. The recipient will be known as a player who continually tries his/her hardest. Merit will not be given for points; rather for effort.

Applications must include:

- Completed Application form
- Conditional Letter of Acceptance (or Acceptance) into a post-secondary program from a recognized institution
- Letter of reference from a former hockey coach
- Letter of reference from a current, academic teacher
- Count of penalty minutes from the 2021-22 season (regular season only)
